11 	B+	----	C+	----	84.3	Massive 11-player heist with 8 on offense led by RB Jeanty & 3 receivers; plus an offensive tackle & guard in the 3rd round; good work here.
12 	B+	----	C+	----	84.3	Stole OT Simmons (was best OT in draft before injury) at #32 after trading down for him for an extra 5th; got some front-7 help as DL Jones is aging.
12 	C+	----	B+	----	84.3	Thin 5-player draft highlighted by a very cagey pick at #24 in Donovan Jackson a versatile talented tackle/guard from Ohio State.

15 	C+	----	B-	----	80.8	Decent volume 9-player draft but got fleeced by Cleveland in reade up for fenom Hunter who won't play 2-way full time, more like 15-20% on Defense.
17 	B+	----	D+	----	79.0	Stood tall denying Giants offer nabbing QB Ward then supporting cast of a guard, RB, TE, and 2 WR's; success.
17 	C+	----	C+	----	79.0	A somewhat sleepy 8-player haul w/ top rated WR McMillan at #8 who siezes up against top competition & could bust. Edge Scourton godd value at #51.
19 	C+	----	C	----	77.3	somewhat head scratching 5-player (of 7 picks) defensive draft for a team needing WR (took none) & QB help (6th round); love RB Johnson in 3rd.
20 	B	----	D	----	75.5	Stole injury prone stud LB Campbell in 1st; sneaky under the radar DT Robinson (DT) in 4th; deep 10-player haul for GM Rosenhaus.
20 	B	----	D	----	75.5	Grabbed three quality top players at OT Membou, TE Taylor & CB Thomas; nothing special beyond that but a decent draft.
20 	B	----	D	----	75.5	9 player hiest yields value at #44 Edge Ezeiruaku, then CB Revel at #76; over drafted #12 IOL Booker & should have traded down then taken him.
20 	B-	----	D+	----	75.5	8-player haul includes a bit of a steal with TE Warren falling to them at #14 hole; weak O-Line gets only a 4th round OT; QB Leonard worth a shot.
20 	C+	----	C-	----	75.5	9-player hail led by offensive skill positions and defensive line, two weaknesses; not sure about a RB in the second round given overall needs.
20 	C-	----	C+	----	75.5	No clue why a team leaded at WR & having many defensive needs takes a WR (Egbuka) in round 1; 6-pick mayonnaise sandwich draft.
26 	C+	----	D+	----	73.8	Walker was great value at #15, then massive overpay in Pierce trade, but get needed pass rush; only 5 picks and 4th round Safety Bowman can't tackle.
26 	C	----	C-	----	73.8	Overdrafted DT grant & G Savaiinaea in first 2 rounds; emphasized DT by taking three for weak d-line; drafted need except no offensive tackle.
28 	C	----	D	----	70.3	Minimal 6-player draft uninspiring as #17 round 1 pick Steward has production questions; we do like the multiple IOL selections...so does QB
28 	C	----	D	----	70.3	Good value with experienced IOL Frazier in 5th; but spent the first 3 rounds drafting players too early; not big on this draft overall.
30 	C+	----	F	----	68.5	Weakening roster gets a franchise left tackle and QB to fill hole left by the major Carr injury; otherwise a fairly vanilla draft.
30 	C+	----	F	----	68.5	11-player heist including 5 defensive players in the first 5 picks; nothing stands out but a good haul for a team that lost 17 free agents.
30 	C+	----	F	----	68.5	No 1st rounder; 2nd round Ersery may be a Guard in the NFL; decent WR pickups for QB Stroud; mayonnaise sandwich draft overall.
